

## INTRODUCTION

The New Testament opens with *two witnesses*, John the Baptist and Jesus Christ who came preaching the Gospel of the Kingdom of God. In Greek the word 'Gospel' means 'Good News'. This Good News is the message by which God the Father is offering eternal life to every human being through his son Jesus Christ. The message of the Kingdom of God is the central theme of the New Testament. For anyone who wishes to obtain eternal life in his Kingdom where there will be no more death, sorrow or sin, the Gospel of the Kingdom of God is the most wonderful and important subject in the world to understand.

Most Christian churches teach the Gospel of 'going to heaven when you die' as the way eternal life is to be obtained. Shocking as it may seem, this is not the true Gospel of the Bible. It is 'another gospel' that Paul warned about.

\* 2Cor 11:4 For if he that cometh preacheth another Jesus, whom we have not preached, or [if] ye receive another spirit, which ye have not received, or another gospel, which ye have not accepted, ye might well bear with [him].

The Christian world has been deceived into accepting this 'other gospel' as well as 'another Jesus' who has long hair, was born on Christmas and has no brothers and sisters. This is not the true Jesus of the Bible. Likewise, they have accepted 'another spirit' called 'the spirit of the world'.

\* 1Cor 2:12 Now we have received, not the spirit of the world, but the spirit which is of God; that we might know the things that are freely given to us of God.

The true spirit of God will give you the knowledge of God from his own mind and heart, lead you to repent of your sins, to believe what he says and to be obedient to his word.

There are many churches today that do know and teach the true Gospel of the Kingdom of God. But their literature only includes a few select scriptures about it. I feel that I am adding to that collective knowledge by having discovered that there are 100 scriptures in the Bible about the Kingdom of God. Reading and meditating on each of the 100 scriptures will provide a more comprehensive understanding on this vital subject.

I feel that no church 'owns' the Bible or the Gospel, and there are many churches that have the right atmosphere and teachings to nourish a growing Christian. If your heart is moved to be converted to God as you study this *True Gospel of the Kingdom of God*, then it is God the Father himself who is working in your heart to open your eyes to his truth and invite you personally into his everlasting Kingdom. Ask him and he will also guide you into a Church according to his will that can best help you grow in grace and knowledge as a true and faithful disciple of Jesus Christ.
