The Molad of Tishri occurred on:

Friday, September 1, 5 BC at 23 hours and 219 parts

The postponement rule(s) used to declare Feast of Trumpets:

Rule(s) 2

The declaration of the Feast of Trumpets is therefore:

Saturday, September 2, 5 BC

Trumpets 5 BC ends civil year 3756 and begins civil year 3757

Civil year 3757 runs from Trumpets 5 BC to Trumpets 4 BC

It is year 14 of the 19-year lunar cycle and has 385 days
