100 SCRIPTURES ABOUT THE KINGDOM OF GOD

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HEALING ACCOMPANIES THE MESSAGE OF THE KINGDOM

Mat 9:35 And Jesus went about all the cities and villages, teaching in their synagogues, and preaching the **GOSPEL OF THE KINGDOM**, and healing every sickness and every disease among the people.

Note: Healing diseases should accompany the preaching of the true Gospel, just as it did with Jesus and his disciples. In fact, Jesus promised that it would.

* Mar 16:15 And he said unto them, Go ye into all the world, and preach the gospel to every creature.

Mar 16:16 He that believeth and is baptized shall be saved; but he that believeth not shall be damned.

Mar 16:17 And these signs shall follow them that believe; In my name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues;

Mar 16:18 They shall take up serpents; and if they drink any deadly thing, it shall not hurt them; they shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover.

Mar 16:19 So then after the Lord had spoken unto them, he was received up into heaven, and sat on the right hand of God.

Mar 16:20 And they went forth, and preached every where, the Lord working with [them], and confirming the word with signs following. Amen.

As we see here, healing is how God works with his disciples, how he confirms that he has sent them to preach and that the words they are teaching people are his true words.

Jesus also confirmed to John the Baptist that he was the promised Messiah by those signs of healing which he did.

* Mat 11:4 Jesus answered and said unto them, Go and shew John again those things which ye do hear and see:

Mat 11:5 The blind receive their sight, and the lame walk, the lepers are cleansed, and the deaf hear, the dead are raised up, and the poor have the gospel preached to them.

Jesus provided for our healing by the beating he suffered before his crucifixion.

* 1Pe 2:24 Who his own self bare our sins in his own body on the tree, that we, being dead to sins, should live unto righteousness: by whose stripes ye were healed.

Here is an example the Lord gave for us if we wish to be healed. We should seek God first, not only physicians.

* 2Ch 16:12 And Asa in the thirty and ninth year of his reign was diseased in his feet, until his disease [was] exceeding [great]: yet in his disease he sought not to the Lord, but to the physicians.

We should be anointed by the elders of the church and pray for one another for healing..

* Jam 5:14 Is any sick among you? let him call for the elders of the church; and let them pray over him, anointing him with oil in the name of the Lord:

Jam 5:15 And the prayer of faith shall save the sick, and the Lord shall raise him up; and if he have committed sins, they shall be forgiven him.

Jam 5:16 Confess [your] faults one to another, and pray one for another, that ye may be healed. The effectual fervent prayer of a righteous man availeth much.

If doing this does not result in healing, there may be other things to consider.

This life is temporary. Everyone whom Jesus healed in his ministry all eventually died of something. So in your case, God may allow the disease to take its course until you die. You will have to bear your cross and continue to follow him.

* Heb 9:17 It is appointed to men once to die.

* Luk 14:27 And whosoever doth not bear his cross, and come after me, cannot be my disciple.

Consider that your illness might be a blessing in disguise to save you from some sin God knows you would commit if you were healthy enough to do so.

* 1 Pe 4:1 he that hath suffered in the flesh hath ceased from sin.

The Lord gave the Apostle Paul great spiritual knowledge, but also allowed him to have an affliction so that he would not be exalted or conceited.

* 2 Cor 12:7 And lest I should be exalted above measure through the abundance of the revelations, there was given to me a thorn in the flesh, the messenger of Satan to buffet me, lest I should be exalted above measure.

It is necessary to have faith in order to be healed. There may be a lack of faith. Or God may use the illness as a test of your faith.

* Mat 9:28 And when he was come into the house, the blind men came to him: and Jesus saith unto them, Believe ye that I am able to do this? They said unto him, Yea, Lord.

Mat 9:29 Then touched he their eyes, saying, According to your faith be it unto you.

Consider that if you are not healed, then seek to understand if there is a lesson that God wants you to learn.

* Read the book of Job.

Are your ears dull of listening closely to to God's word and really applying it in the way you live your daily life?

* Mat 13:15 For this people's heart is waxed gross, and [their] ears are dull of hearing, and their eyes they have closed; lest at any time they should see with [their] eyes, and hear with [their] ears, and should understand with [their] heart, and should be converted, and I should heal them.

Your illness may be the result of a sin you need to repent of. And it is not always easy to really repent. For example, if you have lung cancer because of smoking, how easy is it to stop smoking? Repentance means not only to be truly sorry, but to change our ways.

Exd 15:26 And said, If thou wilt diligently hearken to the voice of the Lord thy God, and wilt do that which is right in his sight, and wilt give ear to his commandments, and keep all his statutes, I will put none of these diseases upon thee, which I have brought upon the Egyptians: for I [am] the Lord that healeth thee.

* 2Ch 7:14 If my people, which are called by my name, shall humble themselves, and pray, and seek my face, and turn from their wicked ways; then will I hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin, and will heal their land.

* Mar 2:9 Whether is it easier to say to the sick of the palsy, [Thy] sins be forgiven thee; or to say, Arise, and take up thy bed, and walk?

Mar 2:10 But that ye may know that the Son of man hath power on earth to forgive sins, (he saith to the sick of the palsy,)

We must examine ourselves before taking the Passover of the Lord. If we eat the bread and drink the cup of the Lord unworthily, we may suffer sickness that is the Lord's chastening.

* 1Cor 11:27 Wherefore whosoever shall eat this bread, and drink [this] cup of the Lord, unworthily, shall be guilty of the body and blood of the Lord.

1Cor 11:28 But let a man examine himself, and so let him eat of [that] bread, and drink of [that] cup.

1Cor 11:29 For he that eateth and drinketh unworthily, eateth and drinketh damnation to himself, not discerning (diakrino) the Lord's body.

1Cor 11:30 For this cause many [are] weak and sickly among you, and many sleep.

1Cor 11:31 For if we would judge (diakrino) ourselves, we should not be judged.

1Cor 11:32 But when we are judged, we are chastened of the Lord, that we should not be condemned with the world.

After all is said and done, have faith in God for he is not only able to heal, but will keep his promise to heal us, if not in this life, then in the next.

* Deu 32:39 See now that I, [even] I, [am] he, and [there is] no god with me: I kill, and I make alive; I wound, and I heal: neither [is there any] that can deliver out of my hand.

* Rom 8:28 And we know that all things work together for good to them that love God, to them who are the called according to [his] purpose.

* Psa 23:4 Yea, though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil: for thou [art] with me;

* Mal 4:2 But unto you that fear my name shall the Sun of righteousness arise with healing in his wings; and ye shall go forth, and grow up as calves of the stall.

* Psa 103:2 Bless the Lord, O my soul, and forget not all his benefits:

Psa 103:3 Who forgiveth all thine iniquities; who healeth all thy diseases;
