## **4 7** JESUS CHRIST SHALL REIGN OVER THE KINGDOM

Luk 1:30 And the angel said unto her, Fear not, Mary: for thou hast found favour with God. Luk 1:31 And, behold, thou shalt conceive in thy womb, and bring forth a son, and shalt call his name JESUS.

Luk 1:32 He shall be great, and shall be called the Son of the Highest: and the Lord God shall give unto him the throne of his father David:

Luk 1:33 And he shall reign over the house of Jacob for ever; and of **HIS KINGDOM** there shall be no end.

Note: Notice here that the throne of the Kingdom is called 'The Throne of David' and the citizens of the Kingdom are called 'The House of Jacob'. Why are the citizens of God's everlasting Kingdom called the House of Jacob?

God is often called the God of Abraham, Isaac and Jacob.

Abraham was a type of God the Father who was willing to obey God's command and sacrifice his only son Isaac. Isaac was a type of Jesus Christ who was sacrificed. Jacob, Isaac's son, was symbolic of New Testament Christians who are called through Jesus Christ according to God's election. Esau, Jacob's brother, was the firstborn son and had the right to the promises that God gave to Abraham. Jacob was the second born. Yet he was elected by God to receive the promises before he was born.

\* Rom 9:11 (For [the children] (Esau and Jacob) being not yet born, neither having done any good or evil, that the purpose of God according to election might stand, not of works, but of him that calleth;

Rom 9:12 It was said unto her, The elder shall serve the younger.

\* Rom 11:5 Even so then at this present time also there is a remnant according to the election of grace.

\* 1Th 1:4 Knowing, brethren beloved, your election of God.

New Testament Christians have inherited the calling and election of our forefather, Jacob. This is why we are called the House of Jacob.
