JESUS PREACHED THE KINGDOM IN GALILEE

Luk 4:31 And came down to Capernaum, a city of Galilee, and taught them on the sabbath days.

Luk 4:32 And they were astonished at his doctrine: for his word was with power.

Luk 4:33 And in the synagogue there was a man, which had a spirit of an unclean devil, and cried out with a loud voice,

Luk 4:34 Saying, Let [us] alone; what have we to do with thee, [thou] Jesus of Nazareth? art thou come to destroy us? I know thee who thou art; the Holy One of God.

Luk 4:35 And Jesus rebuked him, saying, Hold thy peace, and come out of him. And when the devil had thrown him in the midst, he came out of him, and hurt him not.

Luk 4:36 And they were all amazed, and spake among themselves, saying, What a word [is] this! for with authority and power he commandeth the unclean spirits, and they come out.

Luk 4:37 And the fame of him went out into every place of the country round about.

Luk 4:38 And he arose out of the synagogue, and entered into Simon's house. And Simon's wife's mother was taken with a great fever; and they besought him for her.

Luk 4:39 And he stood over her, and rebuked the fever; and it left her: and immediately she arose and ministered unto them.

Luk 4:40 Now when the sun was setting, all they that had any sick with divers diseases brought them unto him; and he laid his hands on every one of them, and healed them.

Luk 4:41 And devils also came out of many, crying out, and saying, Thou art Christ the Son of God. And he rebuking [them] suffered them not to speak: for they knew that he was Christ.

Luk 4:42 And when it was day, he departed and went into a desert place: and the people sought him, and came unto him, and stayed him, that he should not depart from them.

Luk 4:43 And he said unto them, I must preach the **KINGDOM OF GOD** to other cities also: for therefore am I sent.

Luk 4:44 And he preached in the synagogues of Galilee.

Note: Jesus said many times that he was sent by God, his Father. In this passage, one of the reasons he was sent was to preach the Kingdom of God in other cities. Here are other inspiring scriptures showing reasons why Jesus came to us, and why he was sent by God the Father.

1. Mat 5:17 Jesus came to fulfill (fill up to the full) the law, not to destroy it.
2. Mat 9:13, Mar 2:17, Luk 5:32 Jesus came to call sinners to repentance, not the righteous.
3. Mat. 10:34-39 and Lk. 12:49-53 Jesus came to send fire, division, and variance, not peace, as a test to see where our love really is.

4. Mat 18:11, Luk 19:9-10 Jesus came to save that which was lost.
5. Mat. 19:5 and 1 Co. 6:17 For this cause shall a man leave his father and mother and shall be joined to his wife and they shall be one flesh. Jesus left his Father in Heaven to take true Christians as his bride. True Christians shall be joined to Christ and become one spirit with him.
6. Mat 20:28 Jesus came not to be ministered to, but to minister, and to give his life a ransom for many.
7. Mat. 21:37 The householder sent his servants and last of all his son to the husbandmen to receive the fruits of the vineyard.
8. Mar 1:38 Jesus came to preach the Kingdom of God in many towns.
9. Luk. 9:56, 1Tim 1:15 Jesus came not to, destroy men's lives, but to save them.
10. Lk. 4:18-19 The Spirit of the Lord is upon me because he has anointed me to preach the gospel to the poor; he has sent me to heal the broken hearted, to preach deliverance to the captives and recovering of sight to the blind, to set at liberty them that are bruise~, to preach the acceptable year of the Lord.
11. Jhn 1:17 Jesus came to bring grace and truth.
12. Jhn 3:17 For God sent not his son into the world to condemn the world; but that the world through him might be saved.
13. Jhn. 4:34, 6:38 Jesus came down from heaven, not to do his own will, but the will of God who sent him and to finish his work.
14. Jhn 6:51 Jesus came to give his flesh as the living bread for the life of the world.
15. Jhn. 7:18 Jesus came to seek the glory of the one who sent him.
16. Jhn 9:39 Jesus came for judgment, that they which see might see not, and they which see not might see.
17. Jhn. 10:10 Jesus came so that we might have life and have it more abundantly.
18. Jhn 12:27 Jesus came for the purpose of dying on the cross.
19. Jhn. 12:47 Jesus came to save the world, not to judge those who do not believe.
20. Jhn. 18:37 Jesus came into the world to bear witness to the truth.
21. Acts 3:26 God sent Jesus to bless you, in turning away every one of you from his iniquities.

22. Rom. 8:3-4 God sent his own son in the likeness of sinful flesh, and for sin, condemned sin in the flesh: that the righteousness of the law might be fulfilled in us, who walk not after the flesh, but after the spirit.

23. 1Cor 15:21 Jesus came to provide for the resurrection of the dead.

24. Gal. 4:4-5 God sent forth his son, made of a woman, made under the law, to redeem them that were under the law, that we might receive the adoption of sons.

25. Heb 10:7-9 Jesus came to establish doing the will of God and to take away sacrifices and offerings according to the law.

26. 1 Jo. 4:19, 10, 14 God sent his only begotten son into the world that we might live through him, to be the propitiation for our sins, to be the salvator of the world.
