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JESUS SPOKE OF THE KINGDOM AFTER HIS RESURRECTION

Act 1:1 The former treatise have I made, O Theophilus, of all that Jesus began both to do and teach,

Act 1:2 Until the day in which he was taken up, after that he through the Holy Ghost had given commandments unto the apostles whom he had chosen:

Act 1:3 To whom also he shewed himself alive after his passion by many infallible proofs, being seen of them forty days, and speaking of the things pertaining to the **KINGDOM OF GOD**:

Note: These scriptures tell us that after his resurrection, Jesus continued to teach his Apostles about the Kingdom of God for forty days before he was taken up into Heaven. This shows that the Kingdom of God was the central theme of his ministry.

Here is the Hebrew calendar for the year 30 AD showing the dates of Jesus' death on the Passover, his resurrection after three days and nights in the tomb, the day of his ascension to Heaven to be accepted as our sacrifice, the forty days he remained on earth teaching about the Kingdom of God until he was taken up into Heaven again, and the Feast of Pentecost when the disciples received the Holy Spirit.

Pentecost - Sunday, May 28 - Day the disciples received the Holy Spirit							

1.

Jesus died - Passover, April 5 and was placed in the tomb Wednesday evening.

*1Cor 5:7 Purge out therefore the old leaven, that ye may be a new lump, as ye are unleavened. For even Christ our Passover is sacrificed for us:

2.

Jesus was in the tomb three days and three nights according to his prophecy and rose from the dead Saturday evening, April 8.

* Mat 12:40 For as Jonas was three days and three nights in the whale's belly; so shall the Son of man be three days and three nights in the heart of the earth.

Thus Jesus was not there when the women came Sunday morning, April 9.

* Mar 16:2 And very early in the morning the first [day] of the week, they came unto the sepulchre at the rising of the sun.

Mar 16:5 And entering into the sepulchre, they saw a young man sitting on the right side, clothed in a long white garment; and they were affrighted.

Mar 16:6 And he saith unto them, Be not affrighted: Ye seek Jesus of Nazareth, which was crucified: he is risen; he is not here: behold the place where they laid him.

4.

On Sunday, April 9 Jesus ascended to Heaven to God the Father who accepted him as our sacrifice. Later that same day he appeared to his disciples.

* Jhn 20:16 Jesus saith unto her, Mary. She turned herself, and saith unto him, Rabboni; which is to say, Master.

Jhn 20:17 Jesus saith unto her, Touch me not; for I am not yet ascended to my Father: but go to my brethren, and say unto them, I ascend unto my Father, and your Father; and [to] my God, and your God.

Jhn 20:18 Mary Magdalene came and told the disciples that she had seen the Lord, and [that] he had spoken these things unto her.

Jhn 20:19 Then the same day at evening, being the first [day] of the week, when the doors were shut where the disciples were assembled for fear of the Jews, came Jesus and stood in the midst, and saith unto them, Peace [be] unto you.

The Last Day of Unleavened Bread, Wednesday, April 12 probably began the forty days Jesus remained with his disciples teaching them about the Kingdom of God.

The forty days ended on the New Moon of Sivan 1, Sunday, May 21. This timing of the forty days must be classified as a theory because we are not told what day it began and ended. But knowing how important the Holy Days and New Moons are to God, this is a good and reasonable theory and it fits very well between the resurrection and Pentecost. Jesus asked the disciples on this day to wait in Jerusalem for the Holy Spirit that they would receive not many days from then. And then he was taken up in a cloud to Heaven.

* Act 1:4 And, being assembled together with [them], commanded them that they should not depart from Jerusalem, but wait for the promise of the Father, which, [saith he], ye have heard of me.

Act 1:5 For John truly baptized with water; but ye shall be baptized with the Holy Ghost not many days hence.

Act 1:9 And when he had spoken these things, while they beheld, he was taken up; and a cloud received him out of their sight.

7.

One week later, Sunday, May 28 was the Feast of Pentecost on which they received the Holy Spirit. .

* Act 2:1 And when the day of Pentecost was fully come, they were all with one accord in one place.

Act 2:2 And suddenly there came a sound from heaven as of a rushing mighty wind, and it filled all the house where they were sitting.

Act 2:3 And there appeared unto them cloven tongues like as of fire, and it sat upon each of them.

Act 2:4 And they were all filled with the Holy Ghost, and began to speak with other tongues, as the Spirit gave them utterance.
