The Sabbath Jubilee chart gives the year 594 BC as the thirtieth year of the Jubilee cycle. 594 – 593 BC was the Hebrew Year 3168 reckoned From Tishri Sept/Oct 594 BC to Elul 593 BC

The reference for the thirtieth year is Ezek 1:1-2

Eze 1:1 Now it came to pass in the thirtieth year, in the fourth [month], in the fifth [day] of the month, as I [was] among the captives by the river of Chebar, [that] the heavens were opened, and I saw visions of God.

Eze 1:2 In the fifth [day] of the month, which [was] the fifth year of king Jehoiachin's captivity,

As we see here the thirtieth year was the fifth year of King Jehoiachin's captivity.

Jehoiachin reigned three months and ten days, from December, 598 to March, 597 BC. He was taken to Babylon after March 597 BC

His first year of captivity was 598-597 BC His second year of captivity was from 597 to 596 BC His third year of captivity was from 596 to 595 BC His fourth year of captivity was from 595 to 594 BC His fifth year of captivity was from 594 to 593 BC

And this agrees with the Sabbath Jubilee chart
