PART 7 WHERE ARE THE LOST TRIBES OF ISRAEL TODAY? SEE FIG 7

As you study in Fig 7, the scriptures that tell where Israel is today, notice that the Bible is consistent from one end to the other in saying that they are scattered abroad throughout the world and will remain in that condition until the Lord gathers them out from all the nations where they are scattered and returns them to their land of Canaan in the Kingdom of God.

So the belief that any tribe is a modern country is a false belief that contradicts the scriptures.

This scripture is one of the few that actually gives specific locations where Israelites are scattered. None of these locations is in Ireland / Scotland / England.

Isa 11:11 And it shall come to pass in that day, [that] the Lord shall set his hand again the second time to recover the remnant of his people, which shall be left, from Assyria, (western Asia in the upper valley of the Tigris River, possibly Germany) and from Egypt, and from Pathros, (upper Egypt) and from Cush, (northeastern Africa comprising large areas within present-day Egypt and Sudan) and from Elam, (far west and southwest of modern-day Iran) and from Shinar, (Babylon, Iraq) and from Hamath, (a city next to Orontes River in central Syria north of Damascus).and from the islands of the sea. (no islands specified)

Anglo Israelists do their best to find scriptures about locations that seem to support their theory.

Psa 89:25 I will set his hand [sceptre] IN THE SEA.

Here they had to add the word 'sceptre' to make it look like Israel is in the isle of Britain. And they did not continue the verse to the end. "and his right hand in the rivers."

Jer 31:10 Hear the word of the Lord, O ye nations, and declare it IN THE ISLES AFAR OFF, and say, He that scattered Israel will gather him, and keep him, as a shepherd doth his flock. It doesn't say that the Lord will gather and keep him IN the isles afar off does it?

Isa 49:12 Behold these shall come from far: and lo, these FROM THE NORTH AND FROM THE WEST [or, from the North-West]; and these from the land of Sinim.

Here they had to add 'or from the north-west' to make it look like Israel is in Britain.

This is another of the few scriptures that gives a specific location for the scattered of Israel. The land of Sinim is defined in the Bible dictionary as the land of the Chinese. The Chinese were called Sin by the Arabs and Tsini by the Syrians.
